ITEM 4.01 CHANGES IN REGISTRANT'S CERTIFYING ACCOUNTANT.

On February 16, 2007, SF Partnership LLP ("SF") provided a letter to tender their resignation as the Company's certifying accountant. The letter advised the Company that the professional standards and firm policies prevent SF from becoming a creditor of a client to the extent that objectivity may appear to be impaired. Accordingly, as a result of unpaid back fees due to SF by the Company, SF is not currently independent and therefore was not in a position to provide any further audit services.

During the two most recent fiscal years and through February 16, 2007, there were no disagreements with SF on any matter of accounting principles or practices, financial statement disclosure, or auditing scope or procedure, which disagreements, if not resolved to the satisfaction of SF, would have caused SF to make reference to the disagreements in connection with its reports on the Company's financial statements for such years. The reports of SF on our financial statements for the past two fiscal years did contain a statement indicating "substantial doubt about the company's ability to continue as a going concern."

ITEM 8.01 OTHER EVENTS.

- a) The Company is considering alternative independent registered public accounting firms and expects to resolve its outstanding back fees due to SF as well as announce a successor certifying accountant shortly.
- b) The Company has changed the address of its principal executive offices to 648 Finch Avenue East, Suite 2, Toronto, Ontario M2K 2E6 effective immediately.
